Concert Guidelines

All concerts take place at Deer Valley Resort's Snow Park Outdoor Amphitheater, located at the base of Deer Valley Resort (2250 Deer Valley Drive South, Park City, Utah 84060). Parking is free. Picnics, coolers, glass containers and dancing are permitted, but animals are not. Deer Valley's food and beverage concession stand is open during the concerts and Gourmet Picnic Bags are available for purchase. To order a picnic bag please visit deervalley.com/picnic. Deer Valley Music Festival performances, presented by Utah Symphony | Utah Opera:

- No photos or video allowed during the performance. Chairs are permitted but must be less than 9" high. Re-entry is permitted. The venue will be divided into two sections with chairs allowed on one side and blankets on the other. Items brought into the venue prior to the gate opening time will be removed. Unattended items left in line outside the entrance gate will be removed. Patrons may only save space on the hill for up to 3 others. Coolers are not allowed in the reserved section

Tickets may also be purchased the day of the show at Abravanel Hall until 6 p.m. on Fridays or 2 p.m. on Saturdays or at the Deer Valley Ticket Office beginning at 1 p.m. Ticket prices will increase an additional \$5 on the rate in effect, day of show. Convenience fees are applicable to ticket prices. Discounted youth tickets (18 and younger) are available for select performances in the general admission section. Children 3 years of age and under are free in the General Admission section

Deer Valley Concert Series:

- Chairs are permitted in the general admission lawn section only and must be less than 9" high. Re-entry is permitted
- Items brought into the venue prior to the gate opening time will be removed
- Unattended items left in line outside the entrance gate will be removed
- Children under 3 are free in the general admission lawn section only
- No pets are allowed

- Gate times will vary per show, please check your ticket for exact gate time
- The general admission floor section of the venue allows guests access to the area directly in front of the stage. This area is a blanket only section, small coolers are allowed. No chairs are allowed in this section
- The reserved seating section provides guests access to the area directly behind the GA floor section. Small coolers are allowed in this section and guests are provided with a chair at the row and seat number of the ticket they purchased
- The general admission lawn section will be divided into two sections with chairs allowed on the west side and blankets on the east side
